

LCBA JANKOWSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This packet contains the scholarship application materials to be used to apply for a scholarship from the Lebanon County Builders Association. The application must be completed and submitted to the Lebanon County Builders Association at 39 Klein Avenue, Lebanon, PA 17042, for review by the Lebanon Valley College's writing Center.

Any scholarship funds that are received which are not used for tuition, books and required supplies in a curriculum approved by the Education Committee must be refunded to the Association. The Association will take all necessary legal action to recoup such funds.

Scholarships will be awarded regardless of applicant's race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age, veteran's status or physical handicap or disability.

OBJECTIVE CRITERIA AND RULES FOR JANKOWSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

1. The Lebanon County Builders Association Scholarships are open to any twelfth grade student graduating from a Lebanon County High School this year (2012).
2. Recipient must maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 grade point scale). **A transcript of grades must be submitted with each application.**
3. To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must have been accepted by a post secondary two or four year college, university or other accredited degree granting institution. The applicant should be planning on receiving a degree or diploma and enrolled in a course of study.
4. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to age, sex, race, color, national origin, religious creed, or disability.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Applications must be **returned by Monday, April 2, 2012**, accompanied by an essay on the topic of:
“Why are extra-curricular events and activities an important part of the education process?”
2. All essays shall be limited to a **minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 500 words.**
3. Essays must adhere to the given topic and be typed or printed on white paper.
4. All applications and essays must be submitted to Frank R. Kocher, Executive Officer, Lebanon County Builders Association, 39 Klein Avenue, Lebanon, PA 17042.
5. A total of up to \$2,000 in scholarships will be awarded.
6. The winning entries will be determined by review of the Lebanon County Builders Association Education Committee, whose decision shall be final. The winners will be announced and notified on or before the last week in May.
7. All essays will become the property of the Lebanon County Builders Association, which may publish or distribute them as it sees fit.
8. Financial need will not be considered when selecting recipients. Scholarships will be awarded based on the essay contest only.
9. The Association will pay the scholarship directly to the school. Each recipient must submit, in advance of receipt of any funds, invoices from an educational institution for tuition. The Association will aggressively seek refund of any scholarship funds which are not used for tuition, books or supplies.
